
TMD EXAM GUIDE:



- Stand directly behind the patient
- Place your fingers of both hands right in front of the patient’s ears where the TMJ is located.
- Ask the patient to open his or her mouth as wide as possible.
- You should be able to feel a space when the patient opens his or her mouth (See Photo).
- Press firmly and equally on both sides.
- Have the patient close their mouth rapidly.
- If pain is elevated on one or both sides, it is highly likely that the patient has TMD.
